## Fall Bear Hunt

Our fall bear hunts consistently produce fine animals. We limit our hunt to 12 persons per season to ensure that each hunter has the best opportunity at a bear. Last season our largest bear came in at 350 lbs. Last fall we set up a pie plate over a Sterno and cooked some bacon in it. The smell travelled for miles and it didn't take long for him to come in. Our rates are \$1750.00 Can. per person (\$500 deposit, minimum 2 persons). The hunting packages run from Saturday to the following Friday and includes:

- Black Bear license
- fishing license

- boat, motor and gas
- active bait station
- retrieval assistance

## Family Packages (Children 15 and under stay for free)

August 2011 is family month at Bear Paw Lodge. From July 30<sup>th</sup> to August 26<sup>th</sup> two adults pay regular rate (\$550 per person) and two children (15 and under) stay for **free**. This offer includes accommodations, one 16 foot Lund camp boat (max capacity of 4 persons) with 15hp Yamaha 4 stroke motor, and gas.

## 2011 Rates

We understand that the economy is still in turmoil; therefore we will **not** be increasing our rates. The rate will remain at \$550 Cad per person per week. Children 15 and under are ½ price.

### Accommodations:

Cabin 1 – 6 person, 2 singles in the loft and a single over double bunk in each main floor bedroom, 4 piece bath, full kitchen, and covered veranda.

Cabin 2 - 4 person cabin, 2 sets of single bunk beds, 3 piece bath, full kitchen with eating counter, dishwasher, front and back decks.

Cabin 3 – 4 person cabin with 2 bedrooms (two singles in each) 4 piece bath, full kitchen with dishwasher, and lakeside deck.

Cabin 4 – 4 person cabin with 2 single over double bunk beds, 3 piece bath, dishwasher, and private deck and dock.

### New Duplex

Two – 2 person cabins. Two single beds, three piece baths, full kitchens, front and back decks. **These accommodations also facilitate handicap persons.**
