Located in remote North-western Ontario, Caribou Lake offers spectacular scenery, fabulous fishing, and tranquility second to none. The lake is 25 miles long and 5 miles wide with over 2800 miles of shoreline. Its west shore borders one of Canada's largest wilderness parks, Wabakimi, which ensures that the lake will remain in its pristine condition for generations to come. In order to keep our backyard in such a beautiful condition, we have "gone green". We are reducing our generator run time by installing solar powered electricity and we are providing recycle bins at each cabin.

For the enjoyment of all our registered guests, Bear Paw Lodge sponsors an annual fishing derby and the winners receive a free return trip the following season. The 2009 winners are:

## Fall Bear Hunt

We maintain an 800 square kilometer Bear Management Unit which allows us to take 16 bears per season. Therefore we have designated one cabin for bear hunters from mid August to the end of September. Due to the cost of bait and labor, we require a minimum group of 2 hunters per week. Our rates are \$1750.00 Can. per person (\$500 deposit required). The hunting packages run from Saturday to the following Friday and includes:

- Black Bear license
- boat, motor and gas
- fishing license
- active bait station
- accommodations
- retrieval assistance

## Moose Hunt

We are finally able to offer non-resident moose hunts. A bull tag goes for \$3200, cow tag is \$2700, and a calf tag is \$1750 (\$500 deposit required). The package includes the tag, hunting license, accommodations, and boat, motor, and gas. Miles of logging roads open up prime habitat for moose. For the resident hunter, our rate is \$525.00 per week per person but does not include a license or tag; you still must go through the resident draw system.

## 2010 Rates

Our rates for 2010 have been increased 5% to \$550 per person per week. Children 15 and under are ½ price.

### Accommodations:

Cabin 1 – 6 person, 2 singles in the loft and a single over double bunk in each main floor bedroom, 4 piece bath, and full kitchen.

Cabin 2 - 4 person cabin, 2 sets of single bunk beds, 3 piece bath, and full kitchen with eating counter and dishwasher.

Cabin 3 – 4 person cabin with 2 private bedrooms (single over double bunk in each) 4 piece bath, and full kitchen with dishwasher.

Cabin 4 – 4 person cabin with 2 sets of single bunk beds, 3 piece bath, fully renovated kitchen with dishwasher, and private dock.

- A \$150.00 per person non-refundable deposit required to confirm your booking.
